SENIORS OPEN HANDICAP SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES & FORMAT

Lake-Geauga USBC Members (men and women Age 50 & Over) are eligible to bowl in this tournament. Members from other USBC Associations may enter by paying an additional \$8 Local Membership fee, if not sanctioned for the 2025-2026 season the sanction fee is \$25.00. All participants must be current members of USBC. Entry Fee breakdown: Bowling Fees \$50.00, Prize Fund \$25.00, Expenses \$5.00 for total of \$50.00.

AVERAGE: Highest USBC certified winter season average 2024-2025 minimum 21 games. If no winter average is available, highest summer 2025 USBC certified average will be used. If neither is available, highest USBC Certified average from 2023-2024 winter season or lastly 2024 summer will be accepted. If none of the above is available, bowler may use current season average in a USBC Certified league of at least 21 games in a USBC Certified league at time of bowling. If none of the above is available, bowler must enter with a scratch 220 average. All Sport or Challenge league averages must be converted using the appropriate conversion chart on www.bowl.com. If converted average is higher than standard league highest average, it must be used. Entrants using a current USBC Certified league average must have verification (league standing sheet or verified by leaguesecretary.com) signed by League Secretary. Any averages **FROM NON USBC CERTIFIED LEAGUES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

10 Minutes warm up/practice session prior tournament starting time. USBC Certified Tournament Rules 319a1, 319a3, 319d and 319e shall apply. Parts of these rules are printed below; refer to www.bowl.com for additional information. (USBC Departments/Rulebook/Chapter6/Tournaments). USBC Rule 319d. Any entrant who has qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300 or more in the past 12 months prior to Entry, must report actual scores, position, and the amount won at time of entry. USBC Rule 319a2 pertaining to the ten (10) pin increase in current average **Does Not Apply.**

Winners of each class (A to F) will in addition to their prize money, receive a free 2026 entry into the Ohio State USBC Seniors Open Tournament. If the first place winner is unable to go, the Tournament Director will go down no lower than four (4) places to find a participant. In the event of a first place tie, in any of the five mentioned classes, the high series game of the four games bowled with handicap, shall determine the winner. If a tie still exists, then the second highest score with handicap shall determine the winner. The 2026 Ohio State USBC Seniors Open Tournament site has not been chosen yet.
