This Tournament is a handicap event, The Handicap will be calculated from 90% of entering average and 225.

The tournament is a **4 game** total Pin fall with handicap to determine the winner in each division.

Bumper bowlers are **not** eligible.

Bowlers will use their highest USBC average as of the 2025-2026 season as verified on bowl.com minimum 21 games. If a bowler does not have an average from the 2025-2026 season, the current season average can be used with 9 games bowled and a current average sheet, if neither exists a bowlers USBC sanctioned average up to 2 years prior may be utilized.

Tournament RULES

1. All bowlers 18 years of age or younger must meet basic United States Bowling Congress (USBC) eligibility rules and must be participating in a certified Lake-Geauga USBC Youth league in the 2026-2027 season to be eligible to participate in this Tournament. Any youth bowler who has reached age of 18 prior to competition must complete USBC safe-sport certification.
2. The following averages will be used for all Bowlers in all Divisions: Bowlers will use their highest USBC average as of the 2025-2026 season as verified on bowl.com minimum 21 games. If a bowler does not have an average from the 2025-2026 season, the current season average can be used with 9 games bowled (certified league or high school is acceptable) and a current average sheet, if neither exists a bowlers USBC sanctioned average up to 2 years prior may be utilized.

SPORT BOWLING AVERAGE – A Bowler must submit and use his/her adjusted Sport Bowling Average utilizing the USBC Adjustment Scale (Rule 203) and identify himself/herself as a Sport Bowler if he/she bowls on a sport condition regardless if his/her Sport Bowling league is certified as such. If you are not sure please report sport average and regular average and put SS next to the avg. with sport shot and once average is adjusted we will use highest avg. Bowlers failing to report a Sport league average will be subject to disqualification.

USBC rules will govern all bowling, the tournament director will enforce the same, only tournament officials and bowlers are permitted in the bowling area.

3. Handicap for this Tournament will be 90% of 225.
4. Divisions will have at least 1 in 2 prize fund payout ratio. The minimum number of required entries per division will be 2 Bowlers. *If a division has fewer entries than the minimum (at the discretion of the Tournament Director), that division can be combined with another division so that the minimum requirement is met..*

All divisions are mixed

Division 1: Boys & Girls (201 + average)
Division 2: Boys & Girls (176-200 average)
Division 3: Boys & Girls (151-175 average)
Division 4: Boys & Girls (126-150 average)
Division 5: Boys & Girls (101-125 average)
Division 6: Boys & Girls (100 or under)

ALL PRIZES WILL BE PAID VIA USBC SMART ACCOUNT SCHOLARSHIPS.

5. Tardy bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time of his/her arrival. Bowlers will receive no pins for the frame(s) missed.
6. No use of alcohol or tobacco in any form is permitted on the premises by youth Bowlers. **NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES (CELL PHONES, IPODS, ETC.) ARE PERMITTED IN THE BOWLING AREA.** Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated - you may be removed from the Tournament by Director/Tournament Official based on USBC Rule 17(d). Violation of any rule or falsification of an entry may result in disqualification of the Bowler at the discretion of Tournament Director/Tournament Official.
7. **DRESS CODE:** All T-shirts will be free of vulgar language or gestures and alcohol/smoking advertisements. **GIRLS** – pants, shorts, skirts or skirts as long as they are no higher than 3 inches above the middle of the knee; no **TANK TOPS OR CAMI TOPS** are to be worn. **BOYS** – all pants will be worn at your **WAIST**, not your hips. The Tournament Director has the right to ask you to change; and, if you chose not to, you will be disqualified from the Tournament.
8. All entrants must check in at least 30 minutes before scheduled time to bowl. Bowler should bring ball and shoes as the center may have a limited supply.
9. Bumper bowling entries will not be accepted.
10. Tournament is limited to the first 100 bowlers
11. Walk-ins accepted based on lane availability.
12. **ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE BOWLERS AREA OR ON CONCOURSE BEHIND THE BOWLERS AREA!!!!**
